
The "UI GreenMetric World University Rankings" is an initiative of the University of Indonesia, which was set up in 2010. The ideology of the

ranking is to rate the Universities based on their contribution towards environmental conservation for a Green and Sustainable Campus causing low environmental impact.

The criteria and indicators used to rate the universities includes: collection of basic information of the size of the university and its zoning (urban, suburban, or rural) profile, degree of green space, electricity consumption to link with carbon footprint, transportation.

## Arabic calligraphy competition to encourage creative talents



These projects contribute to preparing students as professional psychologists and for the job market.


















#### A Virtual tour in the National Archives **Highlighted on the UAE History**
