AAU Faculty at Hajj Symposium

Dr. Maher Hasweh, assistant professor of jurisprudence at the AAU College of Law, took part in the annual Hajj symposium for 1434 AH which was held in Makkah in Saudi Arabia under the patronage of the Ministry of Hajj.
