AAU students get the third best pharmacy student thematic poster award

H.E. Humaid Mohamed Al Qutami -Chairman and Director General of the Dubai Health Authority- visited the booth of Al Ain University of Science and Technology in the 21st Dubai International Pharmaceuticals & Technologies Conference & Exhibition "DUPHAT 2016", which was held under the patronage of H.H. Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Deputy Ruler of Dubai, Minister of Finance, UAE and President of Dubai Health Authority, at Dubai International Convention & Exhibition Centre.

H.E. Humaid Al Qutami checked out the latest developments which were carried out by Al Ain University of Science and Technology, such as the new programs and accreditations obtained
